- Setting the vision, mission and values of ALRA
- Developing strategy to achieve the charity's objects and monitoring and communicating performance
- Ensuring that the charity seeks the views of past, current and future students and that these views are considered in developing strategy and delivering services
- Acting as the guardians of the charity's assets, both tangible and intangible, taking all due care over their security, deployment and proper application
- Ensuring that ALRA complies with all constitutional, legal and regulatory requirements
- Ensuring that the charity's governance is of the highest possible standard
- Ensuring statutory and regulatory compliance
